# INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS FOR REPORTING CANNABIS AND CANNABIS-RELATED SUBSTANCES FOR MEDICAL PURPOSES

## Side Event at the 65<sup>th</sup> Session of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs

The INCB is discussing with experts and competent national authorities' standards for reporting and monitoring of cannabis and cannabis-related substances for medical and scientific purposes as set out in the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs of 1961, as amended by the 1972 Protocol, as well as in the Convention on Psychotropic Substances of 1971. The Board's aim is to strengthen compliance with the international drug conventions, ensuring access to cannabis for medical and scientific purposes for patients while preventing the risk of diversion into the illicit market. The aim of this side event is to update participants on the latest discussions held between the INCB secretariat and Member States, and the advances made in the elaboration of the common reporting and monitoring standards.
